As a threshold social service agency for homeless youth, our mission is to work with the community **offer** support to meet basic needs, **build** strong relationships, and **ally** with homeless youth as they meet their futures off the streets.

Teen Feed works to meet the needs of youth through four integrated programs: Teen Feed Meal Programs, Street Talk Outreach Program (STOP), Support Coordination, and Youth Access to Care (YAC). Teen Feed provides warm meals, supportive resources, and transformative volunteer experiences in University District (365 days a year), Auburn (every Wednesday, Friday), and Rainier Beach (every Thursday).
