WE ARE UNIQUE

Since 1987, Teen Feed has partnered with the community to support youth experiencing homelessness in Seattle's University District. We partner with over 30 agencies, expanding and contracting to "fill the cracks" as needed. If another organization does it better, we let them and focus on our core strengths. **We've never closed our doors—not even for a single night.**



RELATIONSHIPS MATTER

Teen Feed builds relationships that disrupt the pattern of homelessness before it becomes entrenched. STOP and SLY Outreach relationships are often the first positive contact youth have with support services they trust. These programs provide an on-ramp for trust and a foundation for additional **opportunities for empowered kids to move toward stability with self-esteem.**

OUR THREE INTEGRATED PROGRAMS

Nightly Meal Program

Nutritious dinners every night of the year

STOP (Street Talk Outreach Program)

Trained advocates reach out to homeless youth on the streets

SLY (Service Links for Youth)

Connecting youth with housing, education, employment, and mental health resources

WE ARE SMALL AND MIGHTY

With **97% of every dollar going directly to youth support** and no city, county, or federal funding since 2018, we rely on the 59% of donations that come from individuals who see our impact up close. Our volunteer-driven, youth-informed model gives community members a rare chance to stand in solidarity and walk alongside the youth we serve. **Teen Feed is often the final safety net—a place of dignity, hope, and trust. It is the floor they cannot fall below.**
