### Why This Event

*Teen Feed builds community and partnerships to provide youth experiencing homelessness with nutritious meals, care, and support—empowering them to meet their future off the streets. ### Focus 1 | **The Weekend Gap**

While weekday services exist, weekends and holidays leave many young people without safe daytime options, increasing risk during the coldest, longest hours of the week.

### Focus 2 | **Stabilizing Youth at a Critical Moment**

Consistent mentorship and advocacy are often the missing link between meals and housing stability. This Spring Brunch raises essential support for advocacy at the University District Youth Center (UDYC), helping youth **maintain momentum toward housing, employment, and stability.**

### Focus 3 | **Strengthening Programs Already in Motion**

Event proceeds help bridge funding gaps in active programs, allowing Teen Feed to respond to increased demand and document outcomes that more accurately reflect the lived experiences of youth in the University District. Increased demand requires flexible funding to sustain shelter access, weekend programming, and measurable outcomes.
